For the finest vistas, however, you need to go up Great Orme, a limestone headland that towers over Llandudno and features a vast wilderness of diverse nature-filled ecosystems. To reach the summit, simply ride the resort's famous tram or cable car and enjoy incredible scenes of Snowdonia, the bay and the Irish Sea beyond.
